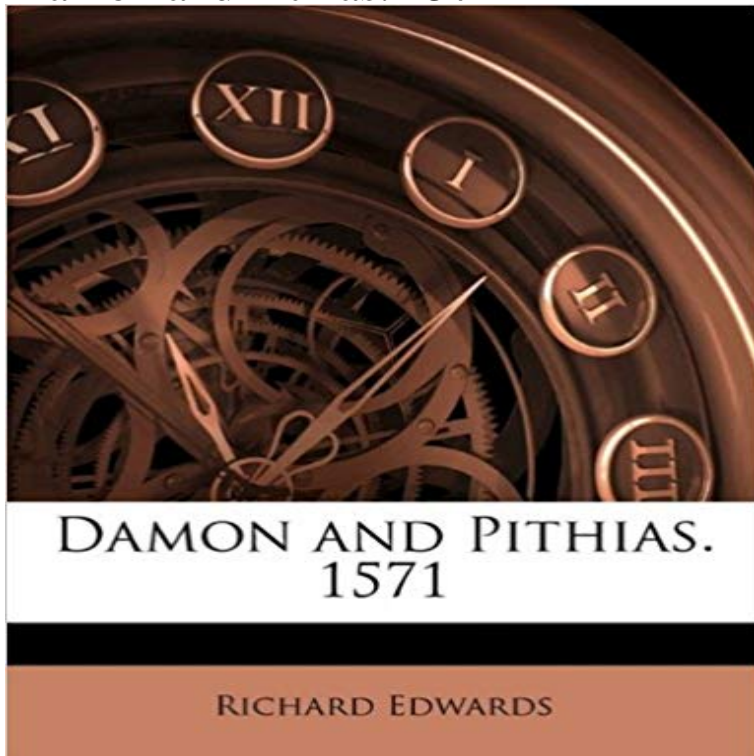


Damon and Pythias. 1571
