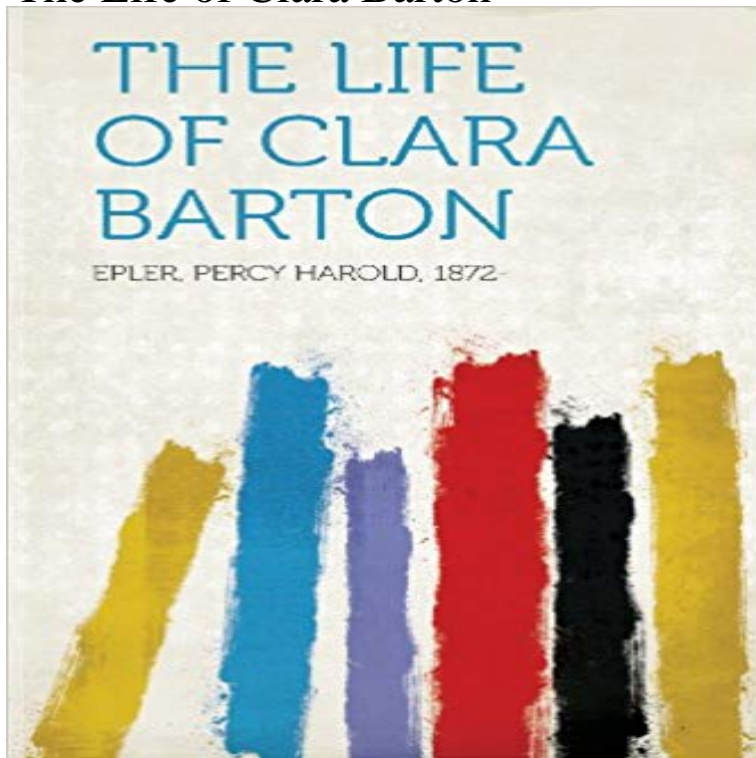


## The Life of Clara Barton
