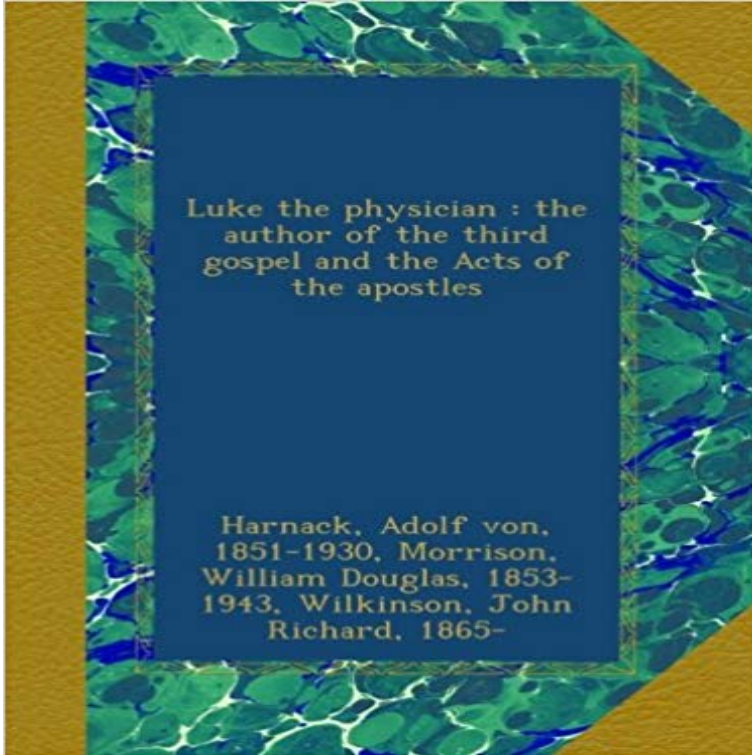


# Luke the physician : the author of the third gospel and the Acts of the apostles
