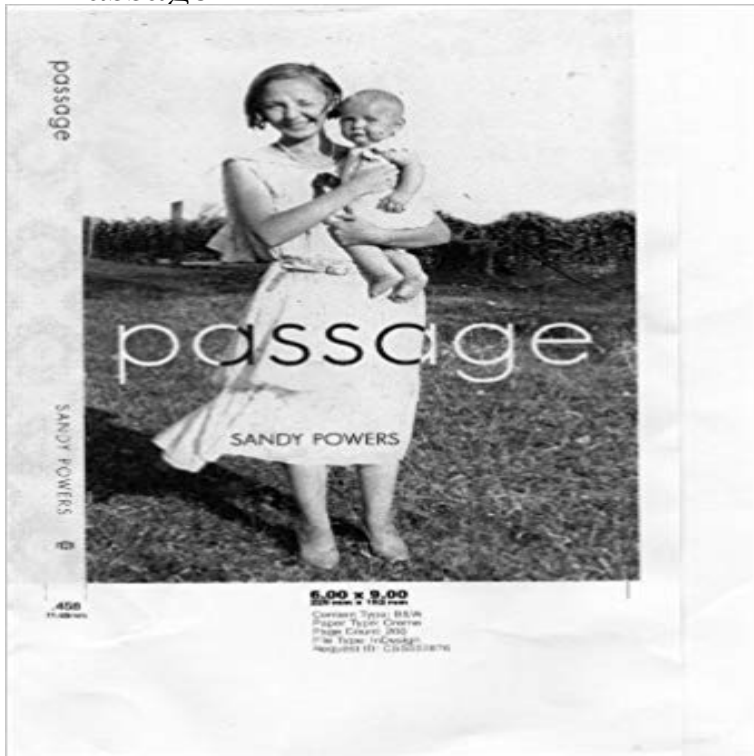


A Passage
