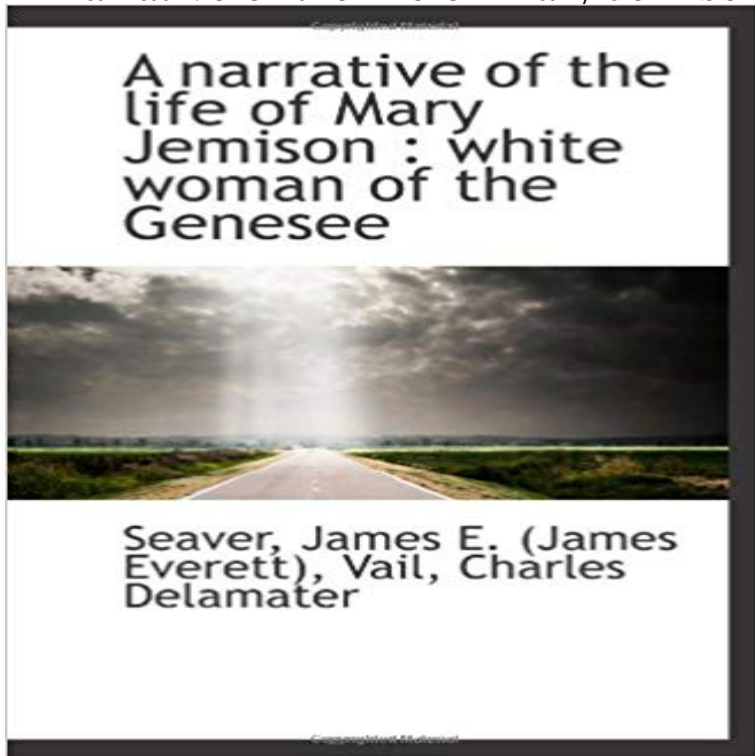


A narrative of the life of Mary Jemison : white woman of the Genesee
